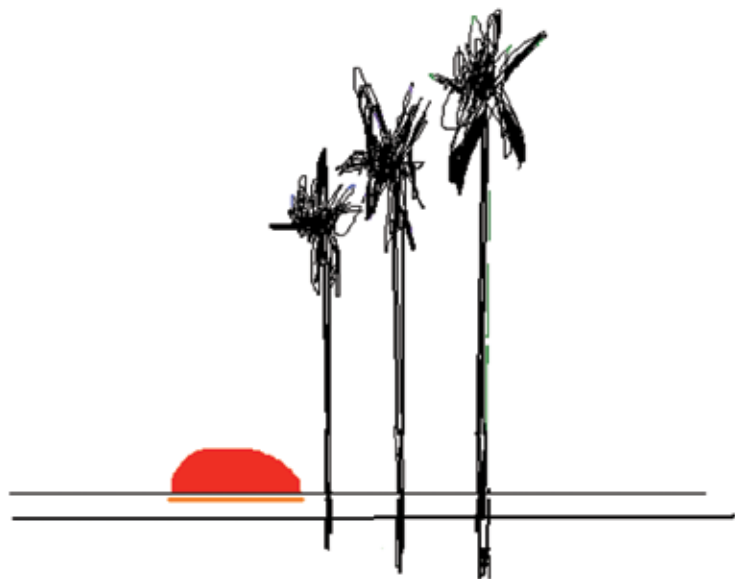

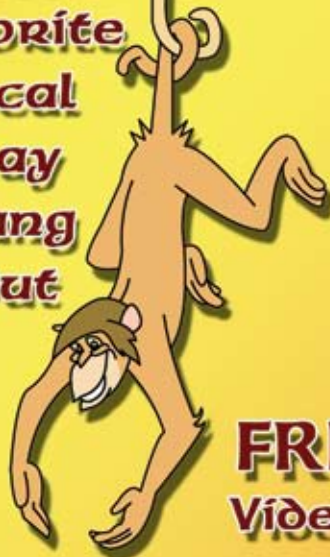
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KW TRIP 2011 – PART 2 "DESI-LUAU"

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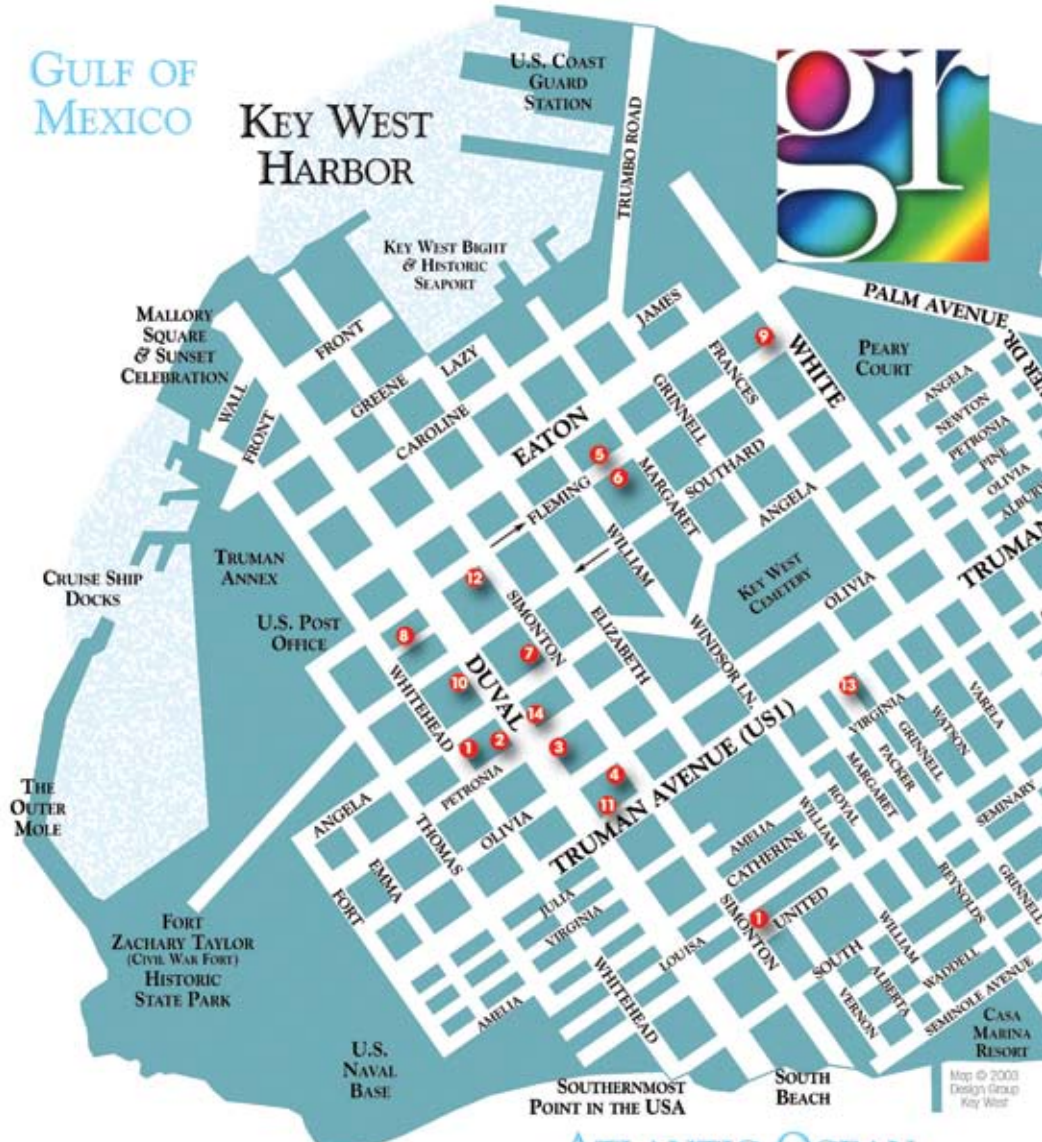

As the Grand Opening of Poinciana Royale, the new 50-unit housing complex from AIDS Help, draws closer, a unique way to participate in its community legacy has been formulated.

Citizens are being invited to help forge pathways of stability, security and shelter for low-income and disabled persons living with HIV/AIDS via a brick-naming project.

For only \$50 per 4" x 8" brick, donors can inscribe their own name...commemorate a significant life event... or honor the memory of another on one of the brick pathways of Poinciana Royale.

According Robert Walker, Executive Director of AIDS Help, "the goal of the Board of Directors is to assure that our friends and neighbor who are disabled and living on a fixed income are not made homeless by market forces. AIDS Help has built 17 apartments for people who are disabled with AIDS in the past four years. Poinciana Royale is our most ambitious project to date."

"We invite everyone to walk with us as we continue to support anyone struggling with an HIV/AIDS diagnosis. Healthy living is a step-by-step process and The Royal Brick Walk demonstrates this aesthetically. All profits generated will support AIDS Help housing programs," Walker added.

A bit of history. After securing over \$12 million in grants and low interest loans, ground was broken on May 13th of last year on the vacant 1.25 acre Poinciana Royale construction site. Coastal Construction began site clearing work for the housing complex immediately and work has remained ahead of schedule for a June, 2011 occupancy goal.

The property will also acknowledge and pay tribute to the stunning fundraising contributions of former Fantasy Fest Kings and Queens, Dukes and Duchesses and Prince and Princess with a prominent main area reserved for their named bricks. (King and Queen bricks will also be imprinted exclusively with a crown in its center.)

"We've made placing an order easy," says Ali Hyatt, chair of the Royal Brick Walk Project. "Just access www.AIDSHelp.cc and you'll find a prominent link that takes you directly to the brick manufacturer."

Each brick can be inscribed with up to three lines with 18 characters per line. The brick color was selected to match the colors of the building and the Helvetica font was selected for all bricks (recommended for legibility and clarity).

People may also inquire at AIDS Help about special naming rights for a water feature in the courtyard, specific living rooms, the library area, or the conference room, according to J. David Cooper, an AIDS Help volunteer working with Hyatt on this project..

AIDS Help, a non-profit, community-based organization, provides case managed healthcare, affordable housing and housing assistance, food counseling, referral and support services for residents of Monroe County living with HIV/AIDS.
