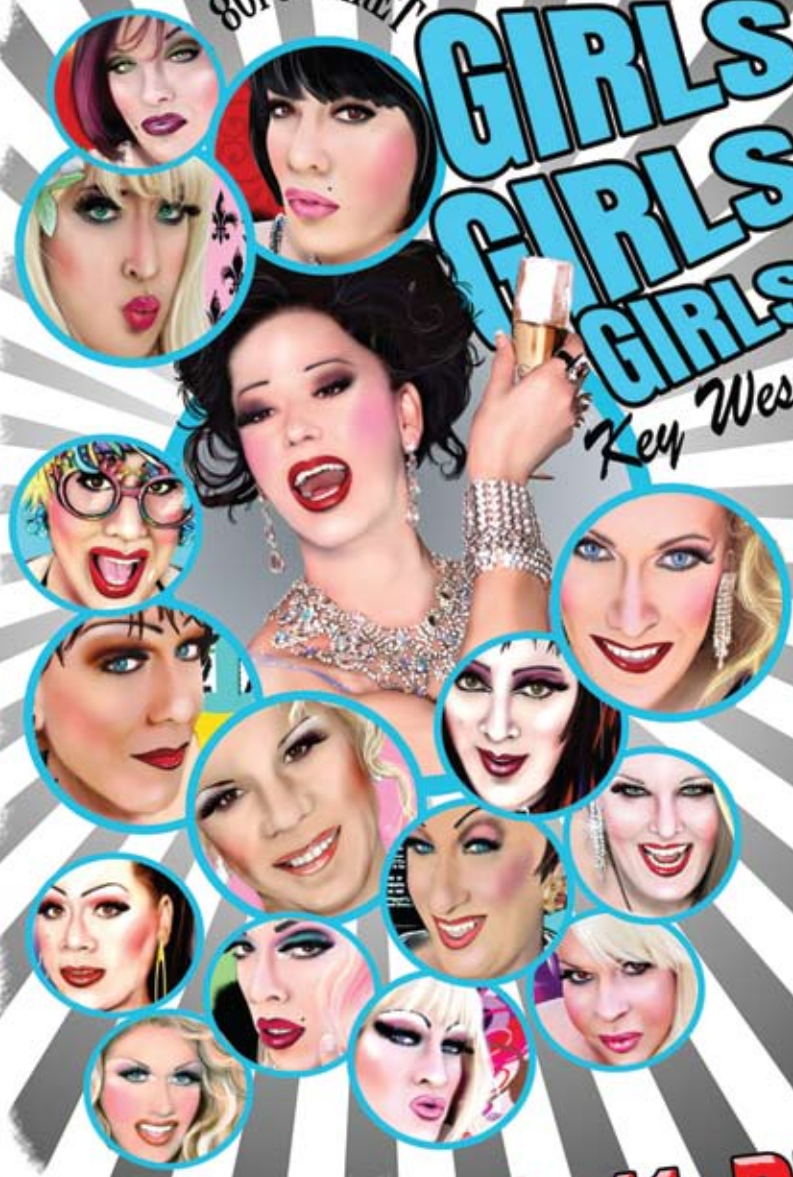

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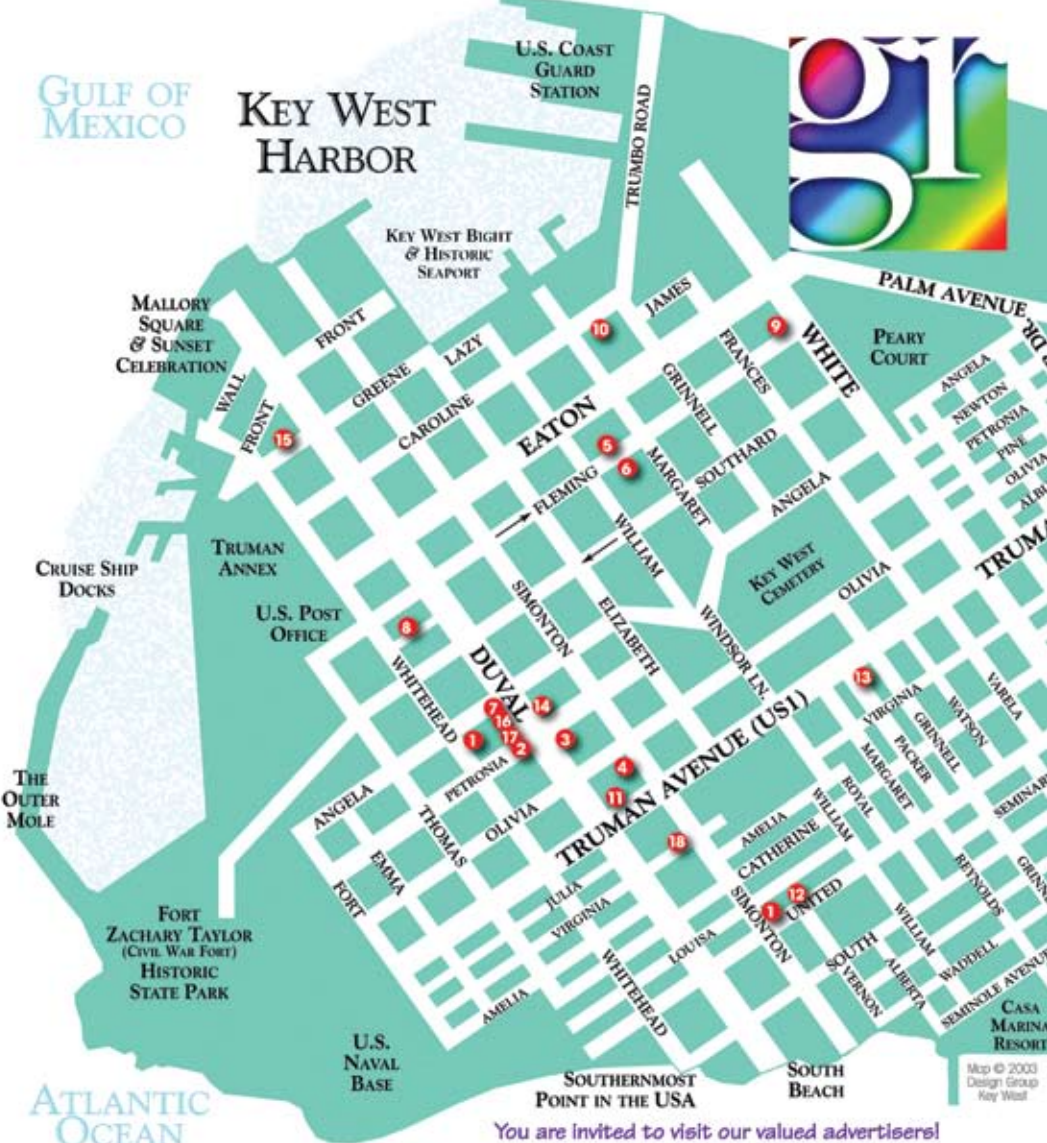

Opposites Attract

These two restaurants couldn't be more opposite – Town and Tavern and Banana Café.

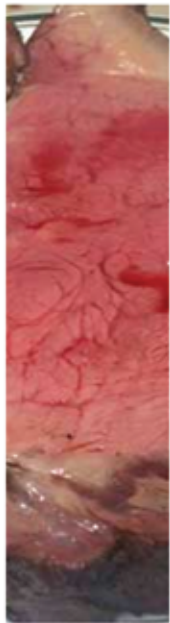
Town and Tavern is located in the Marriott Beachside resort which in turn, is located at the corner of US 1 and North Roosevelt, just as you drive onto the island. It seems out of the way (especially with the construction!) but it's well worth the trek for some really good food.

Town and Tavern's beginnings were auspicious or notorious depending on your perspective. Celebrity chef, Norman Van Aken had been hired to open a high end, deluxe restaurant in the resort.

The construction budget didn't seem to be a consideration given the acres of marble used all over. As the name implies, there was going to be a 'town' side with its own fancy menu and a more informal 'tavern' side with a wide open kitchen visible to both sides.

The earliest days were pretty much a dud though the food was often spectacular. It just didn't seem to click with locals. But flash forward, after Chef Norman skedaddled, the menu got simpler (steakhouse with tapas sort of thing) and the service lightened up and found its mojo. The 'tavern' part can be a tad loud (think sports bar with live music) and there's no real physical





separation with the 'town' part to isolate it. If there's a convention in town, it can be more than a tad loud!

It's hard to beat their slow cooked prime rib for pure beef flavor. They put their winning entry (Master Chef Classic at the Food and Wine Festival) on the menu full time – a kind of riff on surf and turf: oxtail risotto with a pan roasted lobster tail.

Because of the tapas and small plates items plus several pizzas, it's also possible for two people to graze nicely (and lightly) through various selections of their menu, adding a glass or two of wine from their extensive list and have a really wonderful meal.

A couple of miles away – and in terms of environment – on another planet is Banana Café. Located at 1215 Duval, it's well away from the bar scene. The restaurant has two floors as well as a tiny side patio (dogs welcomed!). The food is easy to describe: French bistro. It's my personal go-to place for comfort food, especially in the winter (ok, stop laughing – it does drop to the 60's in January!). Banana Café has been around for 20 years which says a lot for its appeal to both visitors and locals alike. The hosts are always welcoming with genuine warmth that makes it so nice to visit (as opposed to the canned glaze of some maître d's).

The menu is very extensive and you'd be hard pressed not to find something wonderful regardless of how finicky you might be (and believe me, I've got some really finicky friends). The seafood items are market fresh and can't be beat. I'm a sucker for their beef bourguignon whenever it's on as a special.



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PREPARE TO SASHAY AWAY ON NATIONAL GAY MEN'S HIV AWARENESS DAY

You might consider bringing out those fantasy costumes, headdresses and other accoutrement a little early. The Education department of AIDS Help, in alliance with the Florida Department of Health, will be staging its first Gay2Bay Sashay on Saturday, September 29th, from 1:30 to 5:30, starting at The Southernmost Buoy and ending at Mallory Square via Duval Street. "We're calling it a rolling parade," noted Derrick Traylor, Education Director at AIDS Help, "a timed, but casual, stroll down our own Main Street in whatever finery you choose."

The goal: to draw attention to the importance of HIV awareness in the gay male community.

Before we get to the fun of that Saturday afternoon, let's underscore some important facts: More than one million people are living with HIV in the United States; one in five don't know they're infected. Every 9 ½ minutes, a new infection joins this number. That's 50,000 new infections being diagnosed annually in the U.S.

Now consider that Monroe County has the highest rate of white men living with HIV/AIDS in any Florida county...one in every 59 men...and 85% of those identify as gay or bisexual. "This is why we're taking to the streets," commented Mark Buckner, Health Educator at AIDS Help. "This isn't a race. This is whimsy with a purpose: to let everyone know that gay men in the lower Keys are doing their best to take control of their health and demonstrate to bystanders that HIV remains an issue in the Lower Keys." The Sashay is gender nor age specific, it's not even limited to the human race. Bring your dog. Or dress as one. Audition your fantasy best -- or maybe just a portion of it. Whether you walk in heels or on stilts, swing fake hips or a beaded purse, don feathers or leather, carry a parasol or just a pair...a trolley, courtesy of CityView, will lead the way with music and well-wishers.

The 1:30 gathering at the Southernmost Buoy will translate into a 2:00 kick-off...or maybe even a kick line, depending upon the agility of those present.

"The more the merrier," Rodney Ross, Public Information Specialist, explained. "Our dream is to see a delicious swish of people in a rainbow of color making their way down Duval." One requirement that will also ensure participation to the end will be that Sashayers pause at Bourbon St. Pub to pick up a safe sex packet. This will include a safe sex message, three condoms and lubricant...and will also be numbered. A drawing at the celebratory conclusion at Mallory Square will award prizes to numbers drawn. "Of course, the ultimate prize for condom use is a long life, but this is an incentive to encourage people to honestly face their sexual health," says Mark Sciarriolo, Health Educator.

"And the CDC reports that by using condoms correctly, over 98% of couples can avoid transmitting HIV," Traylor elaborated.

No preliminary sign-up is required. Also tune in to 'AIDS Help: On The Air', hosted by AIDS Help Executive Director Joe Pais, on KONK Radio Wednesday, September 5th, from 2 - 3 p.m. Buckner will be elaborating on the fabulousness of the day!
