A little known fact is that I have a Women's Studies degree with a Gender minor. Key West is itself and phenomenal study on gender, it's fluidity and performance. I want to tell you a story about gender in Key West. I normally write mildly comical musings, however, today I want to share a life lesson I recently learned. Buckle up, Buttercup.

I was headed to Flamingo Crossing one evening for some ice cream with my Husbutch. It was a beautiful night that was cool enough to wear pants but warm enough to go sleeveless. A nearly perfect Key West night. As we waited for a good friend to join us, a colorful key west local rolled up on a bicycle and parked it next to a signpost not far from where we were. This sweet human being wears wings, thigh high boots and ... little else. They are completely comfortable with who they are, how they look and they cover just enough to be allowed into places of business. I think everyone who has lived here more than a month has seen them walking Duval or riding their bike around town. I have passed this person many many many times over the course of my history both visiting and living in Key West. I am always glad to see them. Note, I am deliberately not assigning their gender because, in truth, I don't know how they prefer to be referenced. Out of respect, I refrain from making an assumption. Sometime I should simply ask and I will.

As we waited for our friend, a couple of tourists, a man and a woman, were waiting for an Uber across the street from where we stood resting against our car and our newcomer was securing their bike. Suddenly they saw the winged person and the woman apparently couldn't contain herself. She shrieked like a grackle, actually physically pointed and said "OMG! What IS that!!". She continued to bellow laughter and jeers at this person as they walked away. My winged friend just kept walking. They walked into the wine bar next door, chose their spot and sat peacefully drinking their drink seemingly unfazed by the noise pollution this woman was contributing. My

heart was crushed for this person and shocked by the woman. All I could think to myself was that while this woman may have thought that the sight she saw was unattractive, it was she who was ugly. Her heart was just as ugly as could be.

I think it's important to note that I spent the next 24 hours deciding what I should have said, how I should have addressed the situation and how gracefully my gender non-conforming friend moved throughout the whole situation. My reaction was one of anger and hurt. They did not react to her at all. Which was better? There is certainly an argument for both reactions. Should I have told the hateful woman that we don't tolerate that kind of behavior on this island? Should I have said that I felt sorry for how much ignorance, hate and fear she must have inside. All genders are welcome here, period, and hate (no matter how loud) should be stopped and confronted. In Key West you will see many many things that are out of your norm. Observe, but do so kindly. You have an impact though you may only be here for a month, week or a few short days. I won't forget that woman who was so ugly to the person that she thought looked ugly. Someone else's gender, gender expression or attire has absolutely nothing to do with you. I should have said something to that woman and I WILL given the chance again.

That, children, is your lesson on non-binary gender and social construction today... This world is what we make it. Make it kind. Lez Go Out and make it better than how we find it.

BIKTARVY may cause serious side effects, including:

Worsening of hepatitis B (HBV) infection. Your healthcare provider will test you for HBV. If you have both HIV-1 and HBV, your HBV may suddenly get worse if you stop taking BIKTARVY. Do not stop taking BIKTARVY without first talking to your healthcare provider, as they will need to check your health regularly for several months, and may give you HBV medicine.

ABOUT BIKTARVY

BIKTARVY is a complete, 1-pill, once-a-day prescription medicine used to treat HIV-1 in adults and children who weigh at least 55 pounds. It can either be used in people who have never taken HIV-1 medicines before, or people who are replacing their current HIV-1 medicines and whose healthcare provider determines they meet certain requirements.

BIKTARVY does not cure HIV-1 or AIDS. HIV-1 is the virus that causes AIDS.

Do NOT take BIKTARVY if you also take a medicine that contains:

- dofetilide
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- any other medicines to treat HIV-1

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF BIKTARVY

BIKTARVY may cause serious side effects, including:

- Those in the "Most Important Information About BIKTARVY" section.
- Changes in your immune system. Your immune system may get stronger and begin to fight infections

that may have been hidden in your body. Tell your healthcare provider if you have any new symptoms after you start taking BIKTARVY.

- Kidney problems, including kidney failure. Your healthcare provider should do blood and urine tests to check your kidneys. If you develop new or worse kidney problems, they may tell you to stop taking BIKTARVY.
- ▶ Too much lactic acid in your blood (lactic acidosis), which is a serious but rare medical emergency that can lead to death. Tell your healthcare provider right away if you get these symptoms: weakness or being more tired than usual, unusual muscle pain, being short of breath or fast breathing, stomach pain with nausea and vomiting, cold or blue hands and feet, feel dizzy or lightheaded, or a fast or abnormal heartbeat.
- Severe liver problems, which in rare cases can lead to death. Tell your healthcare provider right away if you get these symptoms: skin or the white part of your eyes turns yellow, dark "teacolored" urine, light-colored stools, loss of appetite for several days or longer, nausea, or stomach-area pain.
- The most common side effects of BIKTARVY in clinical studies were diarrhea (6%), nausea (6%), and headache (5%).

These are not all the possible side effects of BIKTARVY. Tell your healthcare provider right away if you have any new symptoms while taking BIKTARVY.

Your healthcare provider will need to do tests to monitor your health before and during treatment with BIKTARVY.

IMPORTANT FACTS FOR BIKTARVY® (CONTINUED)

BEFORE TAKING BIKTARVY

Tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Have or have had any kidney or liver problems, including hepatitis infection.
- Have any other health problems.
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if BIKTARVY can harm your unborn baby. Tell your healthcare provider if you become pregnant while taking BIKTARVY.
- Are breastfeeding (nursing) or plan to breastfeed. Do not breastfeed. HIV-1 can be passed to the baby in breast milk.

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

She shares her things if you ask nicely, and she likes to make you laugh. She seems very smart and polite and she never says mean things to anyone, even if they deserve it. All the kids in your class like her; you like her but in the new book "From Archie to Zack" by

Vincent X. Kirsch, there might be someone you like just a little more.

There was no doubt in anyone's mind. Everybody knew it: Archie loved Zack and Zack loved Archie. The two boys were happiest when they did everything together, but the funny thing was, neither of them could say "I love you."

Oh, but you can bet they both really wanted to say it. Very much so. And then one day, Archie wrote Zack a note that said "From A. to Z. it's true. I love you."

Archie read the note to himself and it really made him smile.

But that note wasn't quite right, so he hid it in a tree and Zack was still his best friend.

He wrote another note, kind of the same. He read it to himself but it just wasn't quite right. He hid the second note in his band case and he and Zack were still best friends.

Just before Halloween, Archie wrote another note, with just a little more oomph and he read it to himself many times. What he wrote finally seemed right this time. He loved Zack! But for some reason, he couldn't give the note to Zack, so Archie hid it in his desk at school.

Then one day, Zuzella found a note in a desk. Zinnia found one in band class. Zelda found one in a tree trunk and all three girls knew who wrote them. They delivered the notes to Zack and that made him smile because he'd been working on a note that wasn't quite right.

One that said the truth that everybody already knew.

Nothing unusual.

That's not normally what you want to hear about a new book; you probably want to hear enthusiastic things like WOW! but that's not what you'll find here. "From Archie to Zack" tells young readers a sweet story in a calm, even, nothing-unusual manner.

The lack of drama is where unusual comes to play.

Author-illustrator Vincent X. Kirsch lets kids know that Archie and Zack can love one another and it's okay. The children in their class don't make fun of anyone. They barely even comment; in fact, they seem to think it's wonderful, a lesson that pulses like a heart here. Even the action-rich illustrations tell a story here, a story about kids that also serves as a surprisingly grown-up conversation-sparker about love, whether it's between friends, classmates, neighbors, or a child's two favorite uncles.

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
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

On his few days off Chef Orr is very laid back, hitting the beach relaxing with his girlfriend, spending the day on the water is always a priority for him. His favorite thing about Key West is the diversity, kindness of the locals which is the main inspiration behind this new venture at Marylin's, a place for locals from various backgrounds to come together, enjoy some amazing food in a casual atmosphere at a fair price and enjoy a good show!



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
