

One of my favorite things to do in Key West, is to get out on a scooter and explore Key West.

Scooters are a great way to explore with a full view of everything around you. No special licenses are required so anyone with a driver's license can rent one. If you have never ridden a scooter before, make sure you let the rental shop give you a tutorial and stay off the busy roads until you really get the hang of it. Helmets are not required in Key West but are certainly a good idea.

Once you've gotten your feet wet and you feel confident going out on the main roads, here are a few places worth exploring.

Head to Southernmost Point and get a picture next to the buoy.

Mallory Square is a great place to see sunset and watch the different entertainers put on free shows, but don't forget to tip.

Head down to the Edward B. Knight Pier also known as the White Street Pier. You can't take the scooter on the pier so park the scooter and walk to the end and take in the view.

While you're in the area stop in to see the West Martello Tower. The West Martello was built during the civil war and is now managed by the Key West Garden Club. You will find many native trees there, and it's also a certified wildlife habitat and a certified butterfly habitat.

Take a cruise along South Roosevelt Boulevard and see the ocean on one side and protected wetlands on the other.

Through all of this, remember to stay safe, and enjoy the ride!

Severe liver problems, which in rare cases can lead to death. - All the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, antacids, laxatives, vitamins, and herbal supplements. BIKTARVY and other medicines may affect each other. Keep a list of all your medicines and show it to your healthcare provider and pharmacist, and ask if it is safe to take BIKTARVY with all of your other medicines.
- If you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if BIKTARVY can harm your unborn baby. Tell your healthcare provider if you become pregnant while taking BIKTARVY.
- If you are breastfeeding (nursing) or plan to breastfeed. Do not breastfeed. HIV-1 can be passed to the baby in breast milk.

BIKTARVY does not cure HIV-1 or AIDS. HIV-1 is the virus that causes AIDS.

Do NOT take BIKTARVY if you also take a medicine that contains:

- dofetilide
- rifampin
- any other medicines to treat HIV-1

BEFORE TAKING BIKTARVY

Tell your healthcare provider all your medical conditions, including if you:

- Have or have had any kidney or liver problems, including hepatitis infection.
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant.
- Are breastfeeding (nursing) or plan to breastfeed. Do not breastfeed if you have HIV-1 because of the risk of passing HIV-1 to your baby.







"THE STONEWALL RIOTS: COMING OUT IN THE STREETS" BY GAYE E. PITMAN c.2019, Abrams Books for Young Readers | \$17.99 | 208 pages



To anybody else, that tchotchke would be worthless.

To you, though, it oozes with memories, and that's why you keep it: because it represents special people, remarkable times, or things you hold in your heart. One glance, and you instantly recall something you want to remember, so in "Stonewall Riots" by Gayle E. Pitman, take a look at fifty objects that represent LGBT history.

Ancient statues and classic paintings can tell you a lot about what people did long ago, and what they thought or liked. The same goes with items that are modern,

although some accounts get "complicated – especially if that story differs depending on who tells it," says Pitman. That's what happened in at least part of the tale of gay liberation: few records were kept, newspapers were mostly silent, and key players have died. Even so, she says, there are enough objects to tell a story.

She begins with a basic history of Greenwich Village in New York City, and the Jefferson Livery Stable, which housed horses long before it became Bonnie's Stonewall Inn, and then just the Stonewall Inn. There's a possibility, says Pitman, that the word "Stonewall" might have been "a coded welcome message to lesbians."

Back then, being gay or lesbian meant almost certain persecution but a gay man named Harry Hay and three of his friends knew that the best way to work against discrimination was to organize. They started the Mattachine Society in 1950, and Pitman includes a photo of one of their early meetings. Five years later, Del Martin and Phyllis Lyon started the Daughters of Bilitis, an organization for lesbians.

And yet, the discrimination continued and "in 1966, resistance was in the air." African Americans had been fighting for civil rights for "quite some time," and antiwar protests were just starting to organize. Small uprisings had been staged on behalf of LGBT people in California, while in New York, LGBT individuals were getting pretty tired of police harassment, Mafia shake-downs, and raids on their hangouts.

And on June 28, 1969, their simmering anger boiled over...

Do ten-year-olds have difficulty grasping happenings in their greatgrandparents' day? It may seem so, which is why parents will be glad that "The Stonewall Riots" is written in the way that it is.

Using photographs, matchbook covers, clothing, and other ephemera, author Gayle E. Pitman makes LGBT history into something relatable for its intended audience because, as you know, kids are big on keeping mementos and special objects. Through the stories of selected items, Pitman explains the events surrounding the night of the riot and she draws a few threads between then and now, but she's careful not to be too hasty in filling in historical blanks. Those unknowns serve to leave kids hanging a bit, and they heighten the excitement and outrage of what happened.

While this is a book for children ages ten and up, this book is also for anyone under the age of 55. You wouldn't remember the Riots first-hand, so reading "The Stonewall Riots" is absolutely worthwhile.





It's no secret that I travel a lot and that I love it. I truly enjoy seeing other places and cultures. And I can assure you that I'm not the American who seeks out a Micky D's the minute I land on foreign shores. That being said, I can't deny the fact I am an American. I mean, I've tried to pull off being Canadian just because people seem to like them more. But, in the end, my unshakable New Yorkness always betrays my ruse. The timbre and volume of my voice are distinctly American. As is my passion for ice in everything I drink and in "Winter is coming" level air conditioning in hotel rooms.

Nowhere I've ever been has it been more obvious that I'm "not from here" as it was on my recent visit to Tokyo. I was excited to finally visit this iconic city and was, in many ways, impressed by its forest-like city gardens and awe-inspiring sushi game. Yet it was also never so painfully obvious that I am a big American. And the emphasis is on big. They don't make Tokyo in my size. And what's shocking about this is I'm not even that big by American standards. Certainly not straight-American standards. Hell, I'm positively athletic for a Wisconsin State Fair! And then I slowly waddle down the scale into Hollywood "character actor" fat. But dear, fictional Christ am I large in Tokyo. My small, but amenity-filled hotel in the Shinjuku district of Tokyo was my first tip off to what my long weekend here would be like. The hotel's soft, cotton robe barely covered both my nipples (if I exhaled and beveled) while just barely clearing my right testicle... which is my most pendulous of the set. They provided two different kinds of slippers: a soft, terry pair and a rather gorgeous, chocolate brown leather pair. I have no idea what cheese they were aiming for, the wedge on the bag vaguely implied a Gouda. But I can tell you that this bag more closely resembled the flavor profile of cheesy Captain Crunch. I did have some of the best sushi of my life there. Which should come as no surprise. So good that I think I have to give up American sushi for a few months so I don't judge it too harshly in the wake of Japan's mouth-watering marvelousness. STAY SAFE RIDE SMART



A bicycle is a great way to get around, but stay safe by following the rules of the road.


- A bicycle is like any other vehicle, so you must follow the rules of the road.
 - Bicycles must follow all traffic controls such as signs and signals.
 - Bicycles cannot travel the wrong way down a one way street.
 - Bicycles must be ridden on the right hand side of a two way street.
 - You must signal all turns with hand signals.
 - Headsets cannot be worn while cycling.
 - Riding a bike while under the influence can get you a DUI in Florida.
- Lights are required between sunset and sunrise
 - A white light is required in front and a red light in the rear.
- Riding on the sidewalk or crosswalk is permitted but with these provisions
 - Pedestrians have the right of way. Yield to pedestrians.
- When passing pedestrians, you must signal your intent before doing so.
- Anyone under the age of 16 must wear a helmet.

Here are a few additional tips that you may find helpful.

- Lock up your bike at all times. If not, you'll probably be walking home.
 - Pass the lock through the frame and the front tire.
 - Be careful not to lock your bike to an adjoining bike by accident.
 - If you lock your bike to private property, it may be impounded.
- When approaching occupied cars, be ready to react if the door opens.



A while ago, my friend Michael was telling me a story about an encounter he had and while telling me the details, he spoke of some horrendous bathhouse etiquette. It was at that time that I realized, many others may need a refresher course on proper bathhouse etiquette.

These guidelines aren't just for bathhouses. These should be applied in bookstores, guesthouses, backrooms, and anywhere else guys get together to get it on!


