I've mentioned before that this island doesn't need an excuse for a parade. One can be walking down any part of Duval St and without notice a group of perhaps vintage cars, lighted bicyclists or a bachelorette group will form a seemingly random procession of like-minded individuals taking over the traffic flow and gleefully prance down the street. In December this happens frequently. Maybe it is because we can don multiple layers without sweating buckets or that the population of the island has nearly doubled giving one more of an audience at any given moment. I am unsure, but it is truly the most fun time of year here.

When I first moved to the island, I had someone tell me with a faraway look in her eye that she had never seen the island sparkle more or be more enchanting than during the Holidays. They light up almost every palm tree with lights, the houses on all parts of the island make their whole houses glow from top to bottom unlike anywhere else. Now, we get no snow here so the locals ... improvise. Everything from bubble machines to dry ice (in large but safe quantities) are used to make a tropical snow globe of this town.

The BEST way to enjoy ALL of this is to take the Holiday Lights Conch Train tour to see them. There is a contest for the best dressed house, who usually has goodies. You must get tickets early because it sells out every single year. The 31st Annual Schooner Wharf Bar & Galley Lighted Boat Parade, Saturday, December 10th. The parade begins at 8:00 p.m. at the Historic Seaport.

To finish out the year, there is always New Year's Eve. No one does it like my island. You get to choose between a wench, a conch and a drag queen drop. All three are a spectacle and the energy is not for the faint of heart. Crowds are big, drinks are flowing and beads are everywhere. I tend to stick to the rainbow end of the street where Sushi, our resident drag queen extraordinaire has been dropped slowly from the roof of Bourbon St Bar in a GIANT, red, dazzling, I'll-get-you-my-pretty version of a high heel for decades. She retired last year and so this year rumors are spreading that is will a surprise!! I have heard that our new queen will be someone I adore and who is an equally famous personality. To be announced soon! Just be here to find out.

Key West is a magical place year-round and whether you're any version or gay or any version of straight, December here is for you. The Husbutch and I will be out and about so look for us on the holiday lights conch train, at the harbor for the boat parade and celebrating our fantastic drag this season out and about. So, Lez Go Out and look for the joy, spread the Key West love and celebrate not having a single real flake of snow!!! See you out there. - dofetilide
- rifampin
- any other medicines to treat HIV-1

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF BIKTARVY

BIKTARVY may cause serious side effects, including:

- Those in the "Most Important Information About BIKTARVY" section.
- Changes in your immune system. Your immune system may get stronger and begin to fight infections that may have been hidden in your body.

Tell your healthcare provider if you have any new symptoms after you start taking BIKTARVY.

- Kidney problems, including kidney failure. Your healthcare provider should do blood and urine tests to check your kidneys. If you develop new or worse kidney problems, they may tell you to stop taking BIKTARVY.


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

Then again, stuffing yourself with stuffing is pretty awesome and that whole Santa-reindeer-elf bit is pretty appealing. Do you have a favorite holiday or, as in "The Jolliest Bunch" by Danny Pellegrino, do you just pick them all?

We've all had 'em: legendary stories attached to holidays that are best forgotten

for at least a little while, until they become family lore. Take, for instance, the various stories Pellegrino tells, beginning with a shout-out to his mother, Linda.

Linda, controller of all holidays, who invites the family over for Christmas Eve at 6 o'clock and then, like clockwork, freaks out at 5:10 "for approximately forty-nine minutes." Linda, who rents chairs for the holiday from a local funeral home. Linda, who once fashioned a passable angel costume from a woman's white shirt.

For a holiday we love, we'll do almost anything to be home with family, including taking a cross-country ride with a half-drunk driver who's on her way to see a former lover with six kids. For a holiday we love, we hold onto Christmas Past by welcoming gay ghosts into our lives. We work retail and endure the same eight holiday songs on every store

speaker, then go home and watch the same four holiday specials on TV. We hope we get the gift we didn't ask for. We celebrate with family and friends,"and sometimes we're surrounded by people we don't like all that much."

And then there are the traditions and the things that make the holiday a holiday: a string of beloved lights that a childhood pet nearly destroyed. Cookie cutters in the shape of the south end of a cat. Enjoying "Midwest comfort foods... that are incredibly delectable and anything but healthy." Knowing that you've wrapped the 100% exact right gift for someone you adore, but also knowing "that even the most special presents are not as important as how you make them feel."

So, here's the brilliance of "The Jolliest Bunch": no matter who you are, man or woman, gay or straight, author Danny Pellegrino has a universal memory to share that's hilariously close to something you've experienced. It's like he was at that same get-together.

This may make you cringe, but you'll also laugh because Pellegrino is a funny writer with a keen eye for a great (and relatable) story. Just beware, though: holidays also bring out nostalgia, longing, missing, and regrets, so watch your heart.

In his introduction, Pellegrino says this book is for holiday haters as well as for those who start singing Christmas carols in August. That means "The Jolliest Bunch" is for you, and reading it's an easy choice to make.
