I used to be said that February was known as the best month of the year in Key West. The droves flocked down to the island sometime in January and all of February was hailed as the best of everything: weather, sun and water... Not anymore. March is the new "it" girl!

Call it global warming, snowbirds moving more slowly (deeper snow) or that Mother Nature is perimenopausal, I don't know... But March is definitely THE month to be here now. The breezes have calmed down, days are a perfect warmth and the nights are absolutely PHENOMENAL for just about everything. Night kayaking, strolling neighborhoods and dining al fresco. The husbutch and I take our 10lb Havanese out for a walk every night and we walk all over town. Cool nights are ideal for hand holding. I digress, the cooler evening strolls often lead us farther from home. The other night we strolled all of the way down through Bahama Village near Santiago's Bodega. Incredible tapas, by the way. You have to finish with the prosciutto wrapped dates. No really. They just about make a vegetarian fall off the wagon. I digress again. Just across the street is the American Legion Hall Post 168 at 803 Emma Street. In addition to being an exceptional resource for our veterans, this establishment currently has one of our own at the helm. Those of you who know Nancy know she is an exceptional force for good in our community. She quietly supports people who don't even know her and may never know she was the silent force behind her good deeds. She has poured her heart and soul into helping make the American Legion Hall a destination and a true resource for veterans within the community in her time as commander. One of the ways that Nancy is working to make the American Legion shine like its glory days is to bring back local jazz.

A little history... The William Weech American Legion Post 168 with its namesake, William Weech, a Black Key Westerner who perished aboard the USCGC Tampa, which sunk off the coast of Wales during World War I, is a uniquely significant institution founded in 1946 by Black WWII veterans who returned to a segregated Key West and built their post home by hand, opening it in 1952. Located at 803 Emma Street, the building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and the Florida African American Heritage Trail, reflecting its role as a historic gathering place once known as the "Black Town Hall." For more than 70 years, the post has supported veterans, their families, and the community, while recent efforts have focused on restoring the aging hall through state grants, city funding requests, and partnerships with organizations like Habitat for Humanity. The reopened hall again serves as a vital community hub, offering veteran services, educational programs, youth mentorship, cultural events, and a planned museum highlighting Key West's Black and military history. The hall has a rich Jazz history, too. Local performers Robert Albury and Coffee Butler have been noted sharing that Louis Armstrong performed there along with many other famous artists like B.B. King, James Brown, Otis Redding, Debbie Wright, Della Humphrey, Ben E. King, Sam and Dave, Millie Jackson, Etta James ("At Last") all performed inside Post 168. In the early years, Bahama Village was the center of music in Key West. It has even been rumored that Duke Ellington fit a portion of his band on that stage.

Today, American Legion 168 has brought its heritage back to the stage with local performers and headlines alike. Expanding its reach the American Legion 168 is also known now as the Key West Cultural Center and Veterans Museum co-located with American Legion Post 168 at 803 Emma St.

They have weekly events such as:

Mondays: 6-8pm, Dinner and the Piano, 8:30-11:30 pm Larry Smith's Jazz Jams \$5 cover.

Wednesdays: Open 6-11 pm. 7-10 pm, Ladies Night w/ Larry Smith, \$5 cover.


Thursdays: Open 6-11 pm. pm. 6:30-9:30 pm. Terri White, Larry Baeder and Friends! \$5 cover.

“THE QUEER THING ABOUT SIN: WHY THE WEST CAME TO HATE QUEER LOVE”

Nobody likes you very much.

That’s how it seems sometimes, doesn’t it? Nobody wants to see you around, they don’t want to hear your voice, they can’t stand the thought of your existence and they’d really rather you just go away. It’s infuriating, and in the new book “**The Queer Thing About Sin**” by Harry Tanner, you’ll see how we got to this point.

When he was a teenager, Harry Tanner says that he thought he “was going to hell.”

For years, he’d been attracted to men and he prayed that it would stop. He asked for help from a lay minister who offered Tanner websites meant to repress his urges, but they weren’t the panacea Tanner hoped for. It wasn’t until he went to college that he found the answers he needed and “stopped fearing God’s retribution.”

Being gay wasn’t a sin. Not ever, but he “still wanted to know why Western Culture believed it was for so long.”

Historically, many believe that older men were sexual “mentors” for teenage boys, but Tanner says that in ancient Greece and Rome, same-sex relationships were common between male partners of equal age and between differently-aged pairs, both. Clarity comes by understanding relationships between husbands and wives then, and careful translation of the word “boy,” to show that age wasn’t a factor,

but superiority and inferiority were.

In ancient Athens, queer love was considered to be “noble” but after the Persians sacked Athens, sex between men instead became an acceptable act of aggression aimed at conquered enemies. Confoundingly, raping a male prisoner was encouraged but “Gay men became symbols of a depraved lack of self-control and abstinence.”

Later Greeks believed that men could turn into women “if they weren’t sufficiently virile.” Biblical interpretations point to more conflict; Leviticus specifically bans queer sex but “the Sumerians actively encouraged it.” The Egyptians hated it, but “there are sporadic clues that same-sex partners lived together in ancient Egypt.”

Says Tanner, “all is not what it seems.”

So you say you’re not really into ancient history. If it’s not your thing, then “The Queer Thing About Sin” won’t be, either.

Just know that if you skip this book, you’re missing out on the kind of excitement you get from reading mythology, but what’s here is true, and a much wider view than mere folklore. Author Harry Tanner invites readers to go deep inside philosophy, religion, and ancient culture, but the information he brings is not dry. No, there are major battles brought to life here, vanquished enemies and death – but also love, acceptance, even encouragement that the citizens of yore in many societies embraced and enjoyed. Tanner explains carefully how religious credo tied in with homosexuality (or didn’t) and he brings readers up to speed through recent times.

While this is not a breezy vacation read or a curl-up-with-a-blanket kind of book, “The Queer Thing About Sin” is absolutely worth spending time with. If you’re a thinking person and can give yourself a chance to ponder, you’ll like it very much.




